



Nayarit

The state of Nayarit is located in the west of Mexico, between the Sierra Madre Occidental and the Pacific Ocean. Nayarit is bordered to the north by the states of Durango and Sinaloa and to the east by the states of Jalisco, Durango and Zacatecas.

Tepic

The state capital is the city of Tepic and is also a head municipality. It is the largest and most populated city in the state.

Safety

According to Mexico Peace Index (GPI) 2017, prepared by the Institute of Economics and Peace (IEP), Nayarit is the second most peaceful state of Mexican territory. The survey that shows these results takes into account seven factors: proper functioning of government, strong business environment, low levels of corruption, good relations with neighbors, free flow of information, equal distribution of resources and respect for human rights.

Economy

An important part of the economy comes from the services sector. Tepic has been ranked as one of the cheapest cities to live. The basic services cost in the region are below those compared to other cities.

The average annual temperature in the state is 77 ° F. The minimum average temperature is between 53 ° F in January and there is a slightly higher average temperature of 95 ° F during the months of May and June.

It is easy and fast to get to any tourist destination since they are all are within two hours at the most, so there will be no impediment to visit all the landscapes that Nayarit has to offer.






Beaches

Access routes

By air

Amado Nervo's International Airport is located twenty minutes from the city of Tepic. Some of the Airlines of this airport are:

Access routes

By land

- Tepic-San Blas Highway. The beach is only twenty minutes away from Tepic.
- Pacific Highway. This road connects with major cities such as Guadalajara and Mazatlán. At only 40 minutes from the capital there are lakes, mountains, volcanoes, dams and more.
- Federal Highway 15: It goes through the state from north to south and extends from Nogales to Mexico City.
- Federal Highway 200: it is on the south coast and connects to all destinations in the municipalities of Bahía de Banderas and Compostela with Puerto Vallarta and Tepic.



Tepic

The capital is located in the center of the state. There are museums, parks, lakes, waterfalls, springs and natural landscapes are beautiful. In addition, there are a number of attractions for those who want to explore this region. From the capital you can reach all destinations like beaches, lakes, waterfalls, mountains etc.

Intensive program PREX 2019
